 - **Be Curious, Open, and Yourself** - This fair is about exploring possibilities, building connections, and getting inspired. You don't need to sell yourself - just be present, engaged, and ready to learn.

What do you do after the fair? Follow-Up!

Your interactions during the company fair may leave an impression, but it is important to follow up with the representatives you spoke to to make it lasting. Here are some tips for ways to follow up after the fair.

1. Send Thank-You Emails

Follow up with recruiters you spoke to, referencing your conversation and reiterating interest. It is useful to include something specific you spoke about to help them remember you but also show that you were paying attention.

2. Connect on LinkedIn

Send a personalized message mentioning the career fair.

3. Apply Promptly

Based on your conversation, tailor your CV to the skills that they mentioned they were looking for or highlight specific mentioned experiences. These are all great ways to stand out. If there was a position you were speaking about, ask the representative if they will look over your cover letter to give any advice.

4. Stay Organized

Keep track of who you met, what you applied for, and your next steps!
